

In flight announcements to be made by all the airlines

- a. “In view of the current Threat of Novel Corona Virus Disease (nCoV) in China and several other countries, all passengers with symptoms of fever, cough, respiratory distress and having travel history to China in last 14 days or coming in contact with people having such travel history are hereby advised to report immediately to the airlines crew and also at the immigration/medical unit on arrival. This is important for early diagnosis and prompt management for preventing spread of the disease. In case a passenger develops any of these symptoms within 28 days of arrival in India, the traveller should seek medical assistance from the designated hospitals and also inform the airport health office.”
- b. “All travellers (passengers and crew) who have travelled to China during past 14 days or coming in contact with people having such travel history would be required to undergo health screening prior to immigration clearance”.
